

**Adobe Acrobat PDF**

We would prefer to receive a Hi Res PDF saved from your creative application. Please make sure that the PDF is exported with output colour conversions set to “No colour conversions” and Profile inclusions policy set to “Don’t include profiles”

**Indesign**

Please ensure that the file is packaged using Indesign’s “Package” option. Please ensure all fonts and images are packaged in this process.

**Adobe Illustrator**

Please ensure all artwork is exported as either CMYK or Spot colour. With no combinations. The file must then be exported Hi Res PDF as above.

**Photoshop**

Images must be saved as PSD, JPEG, or TIF format. Files must be supplied at 300dpi, CMYK, trim size + 3mm bleed all around the document

Please Note: We use the Australian Print Standard **FOGRA39** colour profile.

CLIENT CHECKLIST

- BLEED** - 3mm bleed outside trim edge.
- TRIM MARKS** - Important information must be inset 3mm from your trim marks. Ai or Acrobat art to be centred on page.
- FONTS** - All fonts are embedded or outlined.
- COLOURS** - Only CMYK or spot colours are to be used.
- IMAGES** - All scans and images are correct size and resolution (300dpi).

**Design**

- Strokes must be at least 0.25 point
- Important information such as text and logos must be inset 3mm from your trim marks.
- All fonts must be embedded or outlined.
- All image links must be embedded.

Bleed

- 3mm bleed required.

Colours

- Always use CMYK or Spot Colours; never use RGB or any other colour palette. CMYK only for full colour jobs. Spot Colours only when job is quoted to print in Spot Colour.
